





#### **Getting there**

Our trustee Laura will be catching the 0924 train from Weston-super-Mare station at 0924, arriving at Taunton at 0951 (this is the Penzance train that leaves Worle at 0916). She will be wearing our charity uniform so should be easy to find.

A return ticket for under 16's is  $\pounds$ 5.30. For adults the cost is  $\pounds$ 10.60.

If you are using alternate transport please arrive at Taunton station by 1015. Laura will then lead the walk down to the march starting point, where the rest of the Forum team will be waiting.

#### **Getting home**

You will need to meet back at the Forum's stall in the community area at 1630 to return to Taunton station. Laura will be catching the 1720 from Taunton, arriving at Weston at 1746. (Worle at 1753).

Prior to attending, please come along to an important pre-trip meeting at 2pm on <u>Sunday 10th</u> <u>September</u> in the charity HQ on Meadow Street. See you there!


