It's true! For the first time ever, we are hosting a community day across four venues with special guests, family activities, and of course lots of tea!



**Pixie Dust Resins** will have a magnificent selection of resin gifts, tote bags and ornaments on sale.


Keeley from **The Tower of Temptation** has a brilliant range of crystals, tarot cards and gifts
